Private Pilot - Initial Instructions



1) Ground School


- Formal Ground School is not required per Part 61, but you will need to have an endorsement to take the test
- Multiple options available for online ground school → pick one and start before or during initial part of training
- Recommend King Schools (www.kingschools.com): call them and ask for the 20% referral CFI discount
- Once received your endorsement, schedule the PAR exam (Private Pilot Airplane) at https://faa.psiexams.com/
- You need to score 70% minimum to pass the FAA test (but target for 90%+)

6) Documents to have Before Solo (recommend to get them ASAP)

Student Pilot Certificate

- Register at https://iacra.faa.gov/
- After registration, apply for Student Pilot cert.: look for "IACRA Student Pilot Application Tutorial" on youtube
- Meet with your CFI to finish the process in person

Medical Certificate

- Research 14 CFR Part 67 → Disqualifying conditions
- Look for an Aviation Medical Examiner (AME): https://designee.faa.gov/designeeLocator
- Contact the AME to schedule
- Before the visit, fill out your MedXpress form (https://medxpress.faa.gov/)
